French-English Relations in Canada

Timeline-

As I have mentioned before, there are many themes that wind their way throughout the course of Canadian history. One of the most heated of these is the issue of French-English relations in Canada. Dating back to 1759 and the Conquest of New France by Great Britain right through the 20th century- Meech Lake and Charlottetown, relations between the two cultures have always been subject to debate.

Your assignment has two components:

- 1) Put each of the following in the correct chronological order and briefly explain the historical significance of each to the history of French-English relations in Canada. (Please be sure not to just explain what the event was, but why it was significant!)
- 2) Based on your work, determine which three events are the most historically significant and explain why.

Historical Significance depends on three criteria:

- How notable the event was at the time how widespread and lasting the consequences of the event were?
- How symbolic or representative of historical issues or trends the event were.
- What is historically significant to one group of people is not necessarily significant to others.
