


Reasons for War

- 1) British harassment of American navy ships
 - Orders in council
 - Looking for deserters
- 2) Manifest Destiny
 - American desire to expand and dominate all of North America



Declaration of War

- President James Madison declared war against Great Britain (and thus British North America) in 1812.
- Former President, Thomas Jefferson:
 - Conquering Canada would be "a mere matter of marching"



Heroes and Heroines

Isaac Brock

- British General
- Led Canadian and British troops
- Partnered with First Nations (Tecumseh)
- Tough, daring, bold, professional soldier
- Killed at the battle of Queenston Heights






Heroes and Heroines

Tecumseh


- Shawnee Chief
- Partnered with Isaac Brock
- Resisted American expansion (desired an independent First Nation state)
- Died at the battle of the Thames



Heroes and Heroines


Laura Secord

- Husband was injured at the Battle of Queenston Heights
- Was allowed to rescue husband, but was forced to allow American soldiers to stay in her house, and she would have to cook and clean for them
- Overheard information on an American attack
- Travelled 32km over 18 hours to warn the British
- Lieutenant James Fitzgibbons was able to defeat the Americans at the Battle of Beaver Dams



Important Battles

 - First Canadian Victory
- Beaver Dams
 - Laura Secord
- Lundy's Lane
 - Bloodiest battle of the war
- Burning of York (Capital of Upper Canada)
- Burning of Washington (Capital of USA)
- Battle of New Orleans (Andrew Jackson)
